

RECIPE OF THE MONTH Strawberry Freeze

12 Chips Ahoy cookies
1 package (8 oz.) cream cheese, softened
½ cup sugar
1 can (12 oz.) frozen berry juice concentrate, thawed

1 cup crushed strawberries, fresh or frozen1 tub (8 oz.) whipped topping2 cups whole strawberries, halved

Arrange cookies on bottom of cake pan or 9" spring-form pan. Beat cream cheese and sugar in large bowl with electric mixer on medium speed until blended. Gradually add juice concentrate, beating well after each addition. Stir in strawberries. Add whipped topping; stir with wire whisk until well blended. Pour over the cookies in the pan.

Freeze several hours or until firm. Remove from freezer; let stand in refrigerator for 15 minutes before serving. Place on serving plate. Top each serving with some of the halved strawberries. Store leftover dessert in the freezer.

A BIT OF HISTORY



The father of Horace and John Dodge had a machine shop in Niles, Michigan which became the natural playground for these feisty, young redheads, where grease, gears, and gasoline constantly fueled their fascination with early marine engines. While both were gifted mechanics, Horace developed more as the thinker and John their outspoken representative. But, whether in factory fights or barroom brawls, they never failed to stand by each other for fair play and honest labor.

Not long after opening their own machine shop in Detroit, their reputation was quickly established. First, Ransom Olds decided that the engine he designed for his 1902 runabout should be produced by the Dodge brothers. Then in 1903, came Henry Ford's first order for "650 engines and complete running gears" ---- to his unique specifications. Soon, the Dodge brothers were not only major suppliers to the young Ford Motor Company but stockholders as well. John became a Vice-President and both men were on board. When Henry bought them out, they knew they could make it on their own.

The first Dodge car came off their assembly line, November 1914. By 1920, their huge factory and dealer organization already ranked among the top four in the nation. The brothers succumbed to the flu epidemic of that year and died within months of each other, but their company maintained its position in the fiercely competitive times that followed. Finally, in 1928, the great name became part of Chrysler Corporation. Today, their tradition of performance and dependability keeps the Dodge name a powerful presence in the industry.






