RECIPE OF THE MONTH

<u>Linda Auderer</u> <u>Pflaumenkuchen</u> (Plum Cake)

Ingredients:

3 pounds small, black plums, quartered

4 cups flour

3 sticks butter, cut up

1 cup sugar

1/2 teaspoon salt

4 eggs, divided

1 tablespoon vanilla

Apricot jam

Directions:

In a large bowl, combine the flour, butter, sugar, salt, egg yolks and vanilla. Mix until it forms a dough. Press the dough onto a cookie sheet, forming a slight rim around the edge. Spread the apricot jam over the entire top, and then place the plums in rows to cover. Beat the egg whites until they become foamy, and then brush over the tops of the plums. Bake at 375 degrees F for 35 to 40 minutes.




