RECIPE OF THE MONTH Linda Auderer

Homesteader Bread

3 cups sifted flour 1 cup sugar 1 tsp baking powder 2 tsp baking soda 1 1/2 cups rolled oats 1 tsp salt 2 eggs, slightly beaten 2/3 cup molasses 2 cups buttermilk 1/2 cup chopped nuts 1 1/2 cups raisins

> MIX: sugar, flour, salt, baking powder & soda, and oats in bowl. ADD: eggs, molasses and buttermilk STIR IN: nuts and raisins

Put in 2 regular sized greased loaf pans (or three $8\frac{1}{2} \ge 2\frac{1}{2} \ge 3-7/8"$ pans) and bake at 375 for 15 minutes, turning heat down to 350 for the next 30-45 minutes. When an inserted toothpick comes out clean, it's done. Enjoy!


